A number of volunteers have been working at restoring the station for a number of years. Such work always goes much more slowly than we would like. However, we have restored the siding, windows and the interior of the basement hall, as well as installed a new furnace and a fire warning system. Most of this work has been done by volunteers at modest cost for materials and manufactured items. The modest funding has been able to be raised through activities like flea markets and silent auctions.

We are now at a *new and exciting stage* in this work. The upstairs or the main old station interior is next. We are hoping to make this into a museum to house local historical information, memorabilia and artifacts. A design for this work has already been completed.

This next phase will require much more funding because the scope of work is beyond the capabilities of the volunteers in regard to both skills and normal fund raising activities.

Further, the committee has been in place for some time and is in need of new members. We are especially looking for people with leadership skills and the ability to organize and raise funds.
